The trustees of the Rose Kapingen Foundation are pleased you are submitting an application for a grant. The Foundation was established by the Soroptimist International of Anchorage on Cook Inlet, a service club whose members are business and professional women in Anchorage. The purpose of the Foundation is to provide funds for the higher education of women who reside in the community of Anchorage. It was begun by a generous grant from the husband of one of our charter members and second vice president, Rose Kapingen. Other club members also have bequeathed money to the Foundation.

Amount: Minimum of one award of \$5,000 and an additional \$6,000 to be awarded to one or multiple other applicants, depending on the application and need as determined by the Trustees

Award Study Period: June 2021 through July 2022

Course of Study Requirements: Applicants must present a plan of study which will result in a degree or advance her skills and knowledge in her career. The educational plan may be for college, university or trade school.

Eligibility: Any woman who is a resident of the Municipality of Anchorage and is a U.S. citizen. Preference will be given to applicants who are experienced in a business or profession, have demonstrated the ability to succeed in their chosen field of work, and are desirous of further education to advance their career.

Application deadline: Postmarked or received via email no later than 11:59pm February 26, 2021 Alaska Standard Time.

Selection to be made by: April 2021.

Payment of Grant: A check will be delivered to the winner upon receipt of proof of acceptance for study. The winner will be given a check payable to her university in the amount of the winning grant.

Application Form: Because of Foundation restrictions, the Trustees must require that you complete all information requested on the application form. Resumes or addenda may be added to the application, but may not be submitted in lieu of completing any part of the application. Applicants who submit incomplete applications are not eligible for consideration.

Letters of Recommendation: Attach, do not mail separately, two letters of recommendation, written within 12 months of the application deadline.

Grade Transcripts: Please attach a copy of all post-secondary grade transcripts.
